Minutes of the Meeting

1. WB2: Development of new MSc and BSc programs in AIR

- Francesco summarized progress and plans for WB2.
- Activity 2.1 was completed according to the schedule with only few days delay.
- It was agreed that the two focus groups established in the activity will serve also WP5 and WP6.
- The leaders of these focus groups can change when serving WP5 and WP6.
- The focus groups should start work as soon as possible to make sure that Activity 2.2 is done on time.

2. WB5: Improving curricula of current MSc programs in JO and LB

- Mario presented UST plan for WB5.
- The first activity is 5.1: Developing syllabi and content for added/modified courses in existing master programs in universities of partner countries.
- The 4 proposals from JU, JUST, LU, and BAU for 5.1 should be discussed in a virtual meeting.
- The virtual meeting date and time: Fri 11/6/2021, 10:00-12:30 pm
- Each proposal will take about 15 min to present the existing MSc program and 10 min to present to proposing improvements.

3. WB6: Improving curricula of current BSc programs in JO and LB

- Jorge presented UGR plans for WB6
- The first activity is 6.1: Developing syllabi and content for added/modified courses in existing bachelor programs in universities of partner countries.
- The 6 proposals from JO and LB for 6.1 should be discussed in virtual meetings in times coordinated with other project activities (see Slide 9).

4. WB8: Establishing and developing AIR labs

- Sobhi presented the progress on WB8.
- The formation of the Equipment Committee (EC) is pending nominations from UNIPI and UNIGE.
- The lists of needed equipment with justification has been received from the 5 JO and LB universities.
- It was agreed to insert another column in these lists for the budget in the proposal.
- There will be one tender in JO and one in LB by UJ. BAU will prepare drafts for the tender calls.
- The 5 lists will be discussed in the first meeting of the EC (Slide 9).
- Developing the detailed specs can be done in parallel to getting the approval from E+.

4. WB8: Establishing and developing AIR labs

- The Quality Committee need to review and approve the deliverable of WP1.6 and presented to the SC in the next meeting.
- It was suggested that we should give better attention do dissemination and a good way to do this at this stage is to have a campaign to disseminate WP1.6 report once it is approved.
- Also, need to develop some promotion material like brochures.
- We need every involved persons to participate in the QA evaluation questionnaires.
